Admission to the D. Pharma (Diploma in Pharmacy) course will be conducted strictly as per the norms of the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and the concerned State Government.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Candidate must have passed 10+2 (Science stream) with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with Mathematics/Biology.
- Minimum qualifying marks as prescribed by PCI and State Government.

Admission Procedure:

1. Prospectus & Application Form: Candidates can collect the admission form and prospectus from the college office during working hours.
2. Submission of Application: Duly filled application form along with required documents must be submitted in person at the admission office before the last date.

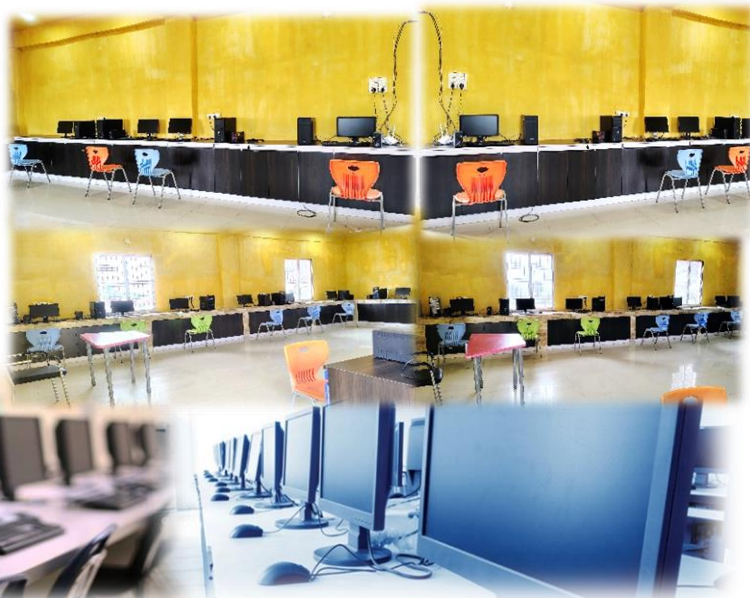
LIBRARY FACILITIES

LABORATORY

MACHINE ROOM
